Present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.618 dated 13.09.2017 under Sections 379-A, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 02.11.2017 and trial of the case still to take some more time. Moreso, co-accused have already been released on bail, so the petitioner be also released on bail in this case.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner is involved in 10 cases of similar nature and, as such, he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having consideration the submissions made by learned counsel for both the parties and the fact that the petitioner is involved in ten more cases of similar nature and is habitual offender, no case is made out for release of the petitioner on bail and the present petition stands dismissed.

However, keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner, learned trial Judge is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously and preferably within a period of six months from today.
