The instant appeal has been filed seeking to challenge the order of the Arbitrator as well as of the District Judge dated 15.10.2005.

In brief the facts are that a dispute arose between the appellant and the respondents which led to the appointment of an Arbitrator who gave his award against the claimant herein. Aggrieved against the said award, the appellant-claimant filed objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for setting aside the award dated 10.04.2003. The objections came to be dismissed which led to the filing of the instant FAO.

Learned counsel for the parties stated that during the pendency of the appeal in this Court, one-time settlement has been arrived at between the parties and as per that an amount as due to the respondent-Punjab State

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Warehousing Corporation stands paid and only a few formalities regarding issuance of No Objection Certificate are pending.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-Corporation does not dispute this factual position.

In view of the fact that a settlement has been arrived at between the parties and only modalities need to be settled, the instant FAO is hereby disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, before parting with this order, in case the dispute still persists and the NOC is not issued, the appellant herein is at liberty to revive these proceedings.
