GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No. 45, dated 12.5.2019, registered at Police Station City Jalalabad, Tehsil and District Fazilka, under Sections 452, 354-A, 506 IPC.
2. The FIR was registered at the instance of Rano Rani wherein it has been alleged that on 8.5.2019 when she was present in her house then the petitioner who is complainant's neighbor came in her house and forcibly held her from her hand while she was alone and when she raised alarm and started crying, the petitioner went away while issuing threats to kill her.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR came to be lodged due to some misunderstandings and that the matter has now been amicably resolved amongst the parties.
4. Mr. K.S.Dargan, Advocate, appearing on behalf of the complainant has endorsed the fact that a compromise has been effected amongst the parties.
5. Learned State counsel has informed that pursuant to the interim directions, the petitioner has since joined investigation.
6. Having regard to the aforesaid factual position wherein the parties are stated to have amicably resolved the issues and the petitioner has since joined investigation, in my opinion it is not a case warranting custodial interrogation. The petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 2.7.2019 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
7. The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
