The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.67, dated 29.03.2017, under Sections 307, 326, 324 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail by the trial Court but he could not appear before the trial Court on 27.11.2018 as he was unwell and his bail bonds were cancelled. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is HIV (+) and copies of the medical reports in this regard have been annexed as Annexures P-3 & P-4.

This Court, by the order dated 04.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner did not appear before the trial Court and learned counsel for the petitioner had sought another opportunity on 18.09.2019 to appear before the trial Court.

Learned State counsel contends that despite another opportunity, the petitioner did not appear before the trial Court and, therefore, the interim protection needs to be withdrawn.

The petitioner has failed to appear before the trial Court despite several opportunities having been granted to him, therefore, this petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
