A complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act was filed as the cheque issued by the respondent was dishonored on account of insufficient funds in the Bank. In view of the aforesaid position, the complainant filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ambala, who vide order dated 13.10.2016 held the respondent guilty and ordered him to be convicted. The Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ambala further ordered the respondent to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of three months as well as to pay compensation in the sum of Rs.2,25,000/- vide judgment dated 14.10.2016. Feeling aggrieved with the aforesaid judgment of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ambala, an appeal was preferred by the respondent, which was dismissed by the learned Sessions Judge, Ambala vide judgment dated 02.06.2018. A revision petition thereagainst was filed by the respondent before the Hon'ble High Court. During the pendency of this revision petition, the parties have settled the matter between themselves as per compromise. The present petitioner (respondent in the complaint) paid a sum of Rs.2,25,000/- in cash, which was received by the complainant. Affidavit to the same effect was also filed by the complainant, which is placed on record. This way, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.

Resultantly, the revision petition is accepted and orders of the judicial Magistrate First Class, Ambala dated 13.10.2016 and 14.10.2016 and the order of learned Sessions Judge, Ambala dated 02.06.2018 are set aside.
