Complainant-petitioner is in the revision petition against the judgment of acquittal passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, affirmed in appeal. There are two unions, one has a name i.e. "Public Carrier Union, Morinda" registered in 2008 and second is "Public Carrier Truck Trailer Operator Society" registered in 2010.

As per case of the prosecution, members of one union have been misusing telephone number, visiting cards and bilties of other union.

Both the Courts on appreciation of evidence, have found that the prosecution has failed to prove that accused had prepared forged visiting cards and bill books.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has made sincere attempt to persuade this Court to take a different view, however, keeping in view the findings arrived at by the Courts below on appreciation of evidence which is not shown to be perverse, this Court does not find it to be a fit case to interfere.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed.
