ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.561 dated 23.05.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC (Sections 325 and 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injured has fully recovered from the injuries and the petitioner has deposited a sum of ₹50,000/- before the Area/Duty Magistrate in terms of the order of the coordinate Bench of this Court.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 12.06.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajeev Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
