The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by providing adequate security / police protection and not to allow respondents no.4 to 9 to interfere in their personal life and liberty in any manner since despite representation dated 16.04.2019 (Annexure P-9), no action has been taken so far.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Additional A.G. Punjab with Mr. Amit Mehta, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondent Nos.1 to 3. Copy of complete paper book be supplied to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, a direction is issued to respondent no.2 / Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the representation dated 16.04.2019 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner and dispose of the same within three months.
