Present revision petition has been filed against the order passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge releasing the convicts-respondents no.2 to 6 on probation of good conduct for a period of two years on furnishing bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount. The convicts were also directed to deposit compensation of Rs.6,000/-.

On 13.8.2018 following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that less compensation has been awarded to the petitioner. He restricts his arguments qua the compensation only.

Notice of motion for 5.12.2018.

In the meanwhile, LCR be also requisitioned.”

Sh. Manoj Tanwar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents no. 2 to 6. With the sincere efforts of the learned counsel for both the parties, parties have arrived at a consensus. It has been agreed that the convicts shall pay another sum of Rs.44,000/- so as to make the total compensation payable to be Rs.50,000/-.

In view of the consensus arrived at, the convicts-respondents No. 2 to 6 shall pay another sum of Rs.44,000/- by way of demand draft in favour of the petitioner – Harpal Singh within a period of one month from today, apart from Rs.6,000/- awarded by the Court of Sessions. The liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival, if the amount is not deposited within the stipulated period.
