Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to petitioners in case FIR No.09 dated 16.01.2019 under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Longowal, District-Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners were not named in that FIR and subsequently on the disclosure statement, six other FIRs were registered against the petitioners. Even the present FIR was also registered against the petitioners on the basis of the disclosure statement. Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that in the other pending FIRs, the petitioners have since been granted regular bail by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of petitioner No.1 Didara, as per which he has already undergone 2 months.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In the present case, the petitioners had not been named in the FIR and have been implicated on the basis of the disclosure statement.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
