On 12.06.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Contends that Balwinder Singh was died by drowning in the canal. Her wife got lodged an FIR to the effect that he had a dispute with the petitioner on non return of tochan of a tractor. Further contends that proceedings were initiated under the provisions of Sections 107 and 151 Cr.P.C but on 20.05.2019, Balwinder Singh had gone on a car and did not return, ultimately his dead body was recovered from the canal.

Notice of motion for 07.09.2019.

Mr. C.S.Bagri, Advocate appears on behalf of complainant and files vakalatnama, same is taken on record. She places on record copy of DDR registered in Police Station Sirhind.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jasvir

Singh, has submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.06.2019 is made absolute.
