ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.135 dated 29.05.2017 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 10 strips of ALPAX-0.5 tablets (100 tablets) on 29.05.2017. He contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail by the trial Court but he did not appear before the Court on one date of hearing due to noting down of wrong date and his bail bonds were cancelled. He further states that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself except the prior permission of the Court. He further contends that recovery which has been effected is non-commercial quantity.

This Court, by the order dated 11.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 23.09.2019 and has been released on interim bail in terms of the order.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 11.09.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
