Instant petition has been filed seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.55, dated 05.04.2017, under Section 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Dinanagar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

It has gone uncontroverted that vide order dated 18.05.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-9295-2018, petitioner was granted concession of anticipatory bail.

However, on account of absenting from trial proceedings on one solitary date i.e. on 18.02.2019, the concession of bail already granted was cancelled on 02.03.2019.

It is the contention raised by counsel that the petitioner had been arrested in another case and on account of which he could not appear before the trial Court on 18.02.2019.

It is contended that absence of the petitioner was not intentional nor deliberate.

Petitioner has now faced incarceration for a period in excess of three months.

In view of the above and without even making any observations on merit, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate concerned.
