ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.45 dated 28.05.2019 under Sections 353, 186, 332, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Dhariwal district Gurdasur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she has been alleged to have torn the uniform of the police official and abused him. He also contends that the petitioner is 25 year old lady and is not involved in any other case. She has falsely been implicated as the husband of the petitioner had preferred contempt petition against SHO Raj Masih prior to the registration of the FIR.

This Court, by the order dated 01.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Harmesh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 01.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
