Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.63, dated 19.04.2019, under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Deceased is Anuradha i.e. wife of the petitioner and who is stated to have committed suicide on 19.04.2019.

Complainant is brother of the deceased, namely, Sandeep Kumar.

Counsel would argue that even as per version of the complainant, it was uncle of the petitioner, namely, Rakesh Sehdev as also one Komal wife of Sushil Kumar who had raised an allegation upon Anuradha (since deceased) of having illicit relations.

Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, the only allegation is that he also earlier in point of time used to trouble his wife Anuradha.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that petitioner had got married to Anuradha about 13 years back and out of wedlock, 2 children were born. During the lifetime of Anuradha, no complaint had been lodged against the husband.

The submission raised by counsel for the petitioner that there are no specific allegations much less any instigation attributed to the petitioner which led to commission of suicide by Anuradha cannot be stated to be without merit.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 21.04.2019.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan already stands presented on 14.06.2019.

In view of the above and without even making any observations on merit, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
