The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.127 dated 11.05.2019 under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

It is stated in the petition that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR would not *prima facie* constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC.

This Court, by the order dated 11.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Lakhbir Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the petitioner having joined investigation and not being required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 11.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
