Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case (Annexure P-6) titled as 'Gupreet Singh vs Rajesh Kumar Yadav' filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 06.05.2019 passed in CRM-M Nos.20385 and 20469 of 2019, to submit that in a similar case, the present petitioner has been granted the concession of interim bail and the trial Court was directed to release the petitioner on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.5,000/-. It is further argued that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and deposit the amount of Rs.10,000/- as costs to the respondent/complainant by way of a demand draft.

Counsel for the respondent has no serious objection to the submission made by counsel for the petitioner and further argued that

the petition be disposed of with a direction that if the petitioner fails to appear and hand over the costs of Rs.10,000/- by way of demand draft favouring the complainant on or before 03.08.2019, this petition may be deemed to be dismissed.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 03.08.2019 and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be paid to the complainant by way of demand draft.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to appear and hand over the costs of Rs.10,000/- by way of demand draft favouring the complainant on or before 03.08.2019, this petition shall be dismissed without any further order.

Disposed of accordingly.
