The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.87 dated 18.04.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 295, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioners along with other co-accused had given injuries on the thumb and finger of the right hand of the complainant. There is no injury on any vital part of the complainant. The petitioners had themselves received several injuries in the incident and the learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the copy of the MLR of the petitioners at Annexure P2 (colly.)

This Court, by the order dated 20.08.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harparshad, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 20.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
