INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.275 dated 02.11.2018, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 13 of the Human Traffic Act, 2012.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Perusal of FIR shows that the present petitioner is the main

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accused and allegation against her is that she has taken an amount of Rs.7,50,000/- for sending complainant-Karan Kumar to foreign country. As per the case of prosecution, it was found during the inquiry that a huge amount has been deposited in the account of petitioner by the complainant.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of the serious allegations levelled against the present petitioner and in view of the fact that she is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
