The petitioner has come up in revision against the order dated 31.05.2019 whereby the prayer of the petitioner for grant of ad interim injunction restraining the defendants from interfering into actual and physical possession of the land in dispute between the family members has been rejected.

It has been observed that CMA-2757-2019 has been fixed for 03.07.2019. Today learned counsel for the petitioner has produced order dated 04.07.2019 whereby the application for ad interim injunction has been dismissed. A perusal of this order shows that family settlement dated 01.02.1996 which was relied upon by the petitioner, was discarded as per the judgment dated 16.03.2016 in the suit filed by the present petitioner for declaration that he is the owner and in possession of the suit property.

On a specific query put, learned counsel for the petitioner states that appeal against the judgment dated 16.03.2016 and 23.09.2013 is pending. Since the finding is already against the petitioner with respect to family settlement dated 01.02.1996, no ground to interfere in the order dated 31.05.2019 (Annexure P-6) is made out.
