The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1649 dated 21.12.2018, registered under Sections 363 and 366 IPC at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner placed on record photocopy of the statement of the prosecutrix recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. A bare perusal of the same transpires that the prosecutrix has gone with the petitioner with her own free consent and nothing wrong has been committed with her.

The petitioner is in custody since 12.01.2019. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Gaurav @ Golu is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
