Learned counsel for the appellant submits that this appeal was filed challenging the order dated 07.12.2004 passed by the Presiding Officer, Election Tribunal, Moga, in which the Election Petition filed by Mohinder Singh under Section 74 of the Punjab State Election Commission Act, 1994 and the Punjab Panchayat Election Rules, 1994 challenging the election of Sher Mohammed as *Sarpanch* of Village Burj Dunna, which was held in the year 2003, has been stated as wrong and illegal.

Since the tenure of *Sarpanch* would be only for 05 years, it is contended that 10 years has already been elapsed long time back and, as such, this appeal has been rendered infructuous.

Having regard to the aforesaid submission, this appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
