Petitioner is seeking setting aside of the order dated 18.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2-Managing Director, Haryana Tourism Corporation Limited, whereby his claim for appointment to the post of Petrol Pump Attendant from the post of Mali has been rejected.

Petitioner has been discharging the duties of Mali for the last 16 years and was posted at Ethnic India Tourist Complex, Rai, Sonapat. There is no petrol pump station in district Sonapat/Ethnic India Tourist Complex, Rai, Sonapat, where the services of petitioner could be utilized. In this backdrop, impugned order dated 18.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) has been passed.

In their written statement, respondents have taken a stand that even though the petitioner has got the qualification of B.Sc. Agriculture, he cannot change his designation from Mali to Petrol Pump Attendant. On the other hand, respondent No.4 was performing the duties of Petrol Pump

Attendant in Haryana tourism Corporation, Tilyar Tourism Complex, Rohtak, since 1993. It has been further stated that two posts of Petrol Pump Attendants were filled from amongst the Malis, who were under matric with six months' experience on Petrol Pump. Only their designation was changed from Mali to Petrol Pump Attendant without any change in the pay scales.

After going through the reply filed by respondents, no ground is made out to interfere in the impugned order dated 18.05.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Dismissed.
