The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 21.02.2019, under Sections 379, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that the allegations in the FIR are that 5000 bricks and 20 cemented poles meant for construction of the boundary wall and room of the complainant were allegedly stolen which were found lying around the wall of the house of the petitioner. He had also contended that the petitioner is 54 years of age and the FIR is an outcome of a civil dispute between the parties which is pending before the trial Court.

This Court, by the order dated 23.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

ASI Baldev Raj, who is present in person, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 23.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
