JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as against the claim of the petitioner to promote him to the post of Sub-Inspector with effect from 26.07.2007 he has been promoted with effect from 24.03.2006. However, the arrears so far have not been released.

In view of the fact that the principal relief has been allowed to the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner is free to represent to the competent authority for the remaining benefit, if any, within three months from today. If such a representation is made, the competent authority shall pass appropriate order as per law. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such

eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
