ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.205 dated 06.03.2019, under Section 420 IPC (Section 34 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mujesar, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had purchased two cars after obtaining loan from the finance company but in the registration certificate, the factum of the cars having been financed was not mentioned. He also contends that the petitioner has already returned a sum of ₹4 lacs to the finance company. The petitioner is not involved in any other case

This Court, by the order dated 16.08.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sunder Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but the recovery is yet to be effected.

Learned counsel for the complainant also opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner saying that the petitioner should be directed to return the money.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 16.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
