The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that the order dated 28.3.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 8358 of 2019 has not been complied with. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

" In view of the above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of the legal notice dated 3.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to take a decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that if any amount is found due the same would be released forthwith.

It is clarified that this Court has not examined the claim of the petitioner on merits."

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Respondent No.3-Mr. Wali Mohammad, AGM (HR) office of GMTD, Ludhiana is present in Court and states that the order of this Court has been complied with.

In view of statement made by respondent No.3, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, in case there is any discrepancy in the statement made by respondent No.3 in Court today, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition.
