ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.69 dated 25.04.2019, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner would not prima facie constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC. It is alleged in the FIR that the deceased had married Sukhdeep Kaur who was earlier married and this factum was not in the knowledge of the deceased. Sukhdeep Kaur left the company of the deceased and started living with the petitioner. Sukhdeep Kaur and the petitioner demanded Rs. 50,000/- before Sukhdeep Kaur rejoins the company of the deceased.

This Court, by the order dated 04.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation

and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Jagroop Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 04.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
