ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 19.05.2019 under Sections 307/323/324/341/506/148/149 IPC, Section 307 IPC already deleted and Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 17.06.2019 the following order was passed by this Court:

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No. 1 Kuldeep Singh @ Kaka was not present at the spot, whereas no role has been attributed to petitioner No. 2 Manvir Singh in the FIR.

Notice of motion for 22.07.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 17.06.2019 is made absolute.
