The petitioner is seeking quashing of the list dated 04.06.2019 (Annexure P4) of the candidates, who have been called for interview for the post of Drugs Control Officer, in pursuance to advertisement No. 6 dated 15.06.2018 (Annexure P1 - colly.).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in terms of the conditions stipulated in the advertisement, the respondents were required to call candidates for interview three times the number of posts advertised in each category. The petitioner had applied for the post of Drugs Control Officer in the Lineal Descendant of Ex-serviceman in General category.

Learned State counsel submits that he has received instructions that three candidates have been called for interview for the sole post in the Lineal Descendant of Ex-serviceman in General category and all these candidates have obtained more marks than the petitioner.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned

counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the petition at this stage.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
