The petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect her life and liberty, as she has been threatened by the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has got an FIR registered against the private respondents under Section 376-D, 365, 341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1862, besides Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959. He also contends that after registration of the FIR, the private respondents have been threatening the petitioner. He has drawn my attention to the representation dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P4) sent by the petitioner to respondent No. 2 - Superintendent of Police, Nuh, Mewat, but no action has been taken thereon.

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Heard. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 - Superintendent of Police, Nuh, Mewat, to look into the matter and take appropriate steps/action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner.
