Present petition was filed with the following substantive prayer:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that present petition be allowed and necessary directions be issued to protect life, liberty and property of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents, in connivance with local police, who have been interfering in his ownership and possession of the land, by helping private respondents to encroach upon it although the petitioner is lawful owner and there is no litigation/order of any court of law against him till date.

It is further prayed that strict legal action be taken against the police officials as well as private respondents who are bent upon to take illegal possession of the land owned and possessed by the petitioner.”

Separate replies have been filed by the State as well as respondent Nos.5 to 9.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bharat Ram, has submitted that the police had went to the spot on the application of private-respondents and had restrained both the parties from raising any construction while relegating the parties to the Competent Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the aforesaid statement made by the State counsel, the present petition be disposed of.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
