Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the investigation in case FIR No.95 dated 08.06.2012, the account belonging to the accused namely Ramandeep Kaur and Sandeep Singh maintained with Oriental Bank was freezed. It is pointed out that the trial in the said FIR has ended in acquittal vide judgment dated 23.02.2017 and the said judgment has attained finality and no appeal was preferred against the same. According to learned counsel, the said account is still freezed and representation on behalf of the account-holders/accused was given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna on 11.05.2019; despite that no action has been taken so far.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State in this petition. A copy of the paper book has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Considering the above, this petition is disposed off with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) given by petitioner and pass an appropriate order, keeping in view the judgment of acquittal in favour of the petitioner.
