The petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect her life and liberty, as she is being harassed by the official respondents at the behest of private respondent No. 5, who is her husband, against whom she has filed proceedings under the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for maintenance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the representation dated 09.06.2019 (Annexure P2) sent by the petitioner to respondent No. 2 - Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Kapurthala, but no action has been taken thereon. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is a lady with two minor children.

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Heard. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the

petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 - Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Kapurthala, to look into the representation dated 09.06.2019 (Annexure P2) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps in accordance with law to protect her life and liberty.
