Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.62 dated 16.05.2019, registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC, at Police Station Division No.8, District Jalandhar Commissionerate.

On 21.08.2019, the following order was passed :-

“Notice of motion for 03.09.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

At this stage, Mr. Shivam Malhotra, Advocate, has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of the complainant. The same is taken on record.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Arun Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and he is not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 21.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall continue to cooperate with the trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.

The petition stands disposed of.
