The petitioner has filed this petition with the following prayer:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be accepted and the respondent No.2 & 3 may kindly be directed to decide the pending representation dated 11.06.2019 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner, in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that a direction may kindly be issued to the respondent no.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family from the hands of respondent No.4 and also a direction may kindly be issued to respondent No.2 & 3 to restrain the respondent No.4 not to threaten, harass, humiliate, torture the petitioner and her family and also to not interfere with the life and liberty of the petitioner in any manner and against their wishes, in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that any other appropriate order or direction which this Hon'ble High Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may also be issued.

It is further prayed that the petitioner may kindly be exempted from filing the certified/photostat/true typed copies of

the annexure P-1 & P-2 and he may kindly be permitted to place on record the true typed/photostat copy of the same in the interest of justice.”

The petitioner has more than one effective remedies.

In the facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court does not find any good ground to issue directions as prayed for.

The petition is dismissed.
