The petitioner is seeking direction to the official respondents to release him on parole on account of marriage of nephew which is to be solemnized on 21.06.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the order passed by the competent authority on 23.05.2019 (Annexure P-1) whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be released temporarily from custody for a period of three weeks from 04.07.2019 to 24.07.2019. He contends that there is an error in the order as the petitioner had applied for parole to attend the marriage of his nephew which is to be solemnized on 21.06.2019. He further contends that the eligibility of the petitioner for temporary release is not in question.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. He is not able to controvert the

submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was indeed directed to be temporarily released from custody for a period of three weeks from 04.07.2019 to 24.07.2019. It is thus apparent that there is an error in the order releasing the petitioner on parole for a period of three weeks.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to temporarily release the petitioner for a period of three weeks from 20.06.2019 to 10.07.2019 instead of 04.07.2019 to 24.07.2019.
