[1] Claim in the writ petition is for the issuance of directions to the respondents to extend the contractual period of the petitioners and to continue their services on the post of Canal Patwaris till regular incumbents are appointed.

[2] Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court has filed reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 in Court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

[3] A perusal of the reply reveals that the contractual period of the petitioners has been extended for another period of six months from 01.08.2019 to 31.01.2020 while mentioning that as far as issue of replacing the services of the petitioners by another similar arrangement is concerned, the same is only the apprehension of the petitioners as the services of the petitioners have neither been discontinued nor terminated till such times as regular recruitment of Canal Patwaris is made in the Department, therefore,

the petition has become infructuous and the same is liable to be dismissed with costs.

[4] In view of the aforementioned reply, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
