On 26.06.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the conceded case, as per the allegations contained in the FIR, is that the alleged weight of poppy husk, recovered from the petitioner, is 02 kg which is way below the commercial limit of 50 kg.

Notice of motion for 24.07.2019.

In the meanwhile, no coercive steps shall be taken qua the petitioner pursuant to FIR No.293 dated 22.09.2017 registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 26.06.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
