Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.213 dated 18.04.2019 registered at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mohindergarh for offence punishable under Sections 323 and 506 to which offence under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code was added later on.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it was the complainant victim who was aggressor and had come to the shop of the petitioner which is clearly visible from the CCTV Footage already examined by the Investigating Agency also during the pendency of anticipatory bail before the Court below. He has further submitted that the petitioner has already joined investigation and iron pipe, the alleged weapon of offence has already been recovered.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Sukhbir Singh, has submitted that injury on the head was later on declared to be grievous and dangerous to life.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, it is considered appropriate to direct the petitioner to once again join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State is unable to support his argument with regard to requirement of custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is allowed.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
