HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is for reimbursement of medical bills. An objection is raised by the respondents that it is the Insurance Company, as envisaged in Notification dated 20.10.2015 (Annexure P/3) attached with the writ petition, who is to reimburse the medical claims.

Thereafter, the petitioner has moved an application for impleading the India Insurance Pvt. Ltd. as respondent No.4, which application was allowed by this Court on 30.03.2017.

Counsel for the respondents states that in respect of the claim of the petitioner for reimbursement, according to Clause 7, it was the Oriental Insurance Company Pvt. Ltd, who was to reimburse the medical bills and not the respondent No.4 which fact has been accepted by the counsel for the petitioner as well.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file the same afresh on the same cause of action with better particulars by impleading all the necessary parties, who are likely to be effected by the decision, which might be rendered by this Court on the claim raised by the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
