Learned counsel for the private respondents states that the present writ petition has become infructuous inasmuch as the same was instituted for quashing the renewal of the registration of the private respondents as Registered Medical Practitioners on the basis of their experience by entering their name in para 2 of the register maintained by Council of Indian Medicine, Haryana. He states that the renewal at the first

instance is done only for a period of 5 years and the same is later extended from time to time. The renewal which is under challenge in present writ petition has expired during pendency of the present writ petition and, therefore, the present writ petition has become infructuous. He further points out that even though some of the private respondents' renewal is at the fag end and is likely to expire in the coming 2 – 3 months.

2.) In this view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of as being infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to challenge afresh, the renewal of the private respondents, in the event they apply for the same. Provided of course, they are entitled to seek such a renewal in accordance with law.

3.) Disposed of accordingly.
