The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 99 dated 17.04.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 427, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamunanagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injuries are simple in nature except the fracture on the finger of Subhash which is attributed to co-accused Sahil.

This Court, by the order dated 18.06.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 18.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
