The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.27 dated 19.02.2019, under Sections 304-A & 420 IPC and 15(2) and 15(6) of the Indian Medical Counciling Act, 1956 registered at Police Station Rojka Meo, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the complainant's father had taken treatment for lichens spot from a doctor named Sharif who had administered two injections to the complainant's father which led to medical complications and he lost his life. He also submits that the petitioner was only working as an attendant with Dr.Ram Hari and in the statement of Dr. Ram Hari, he has stated that the petitioner was only working as an attendant with him and would administer treatment to the patients on his instructions.

This Court, by the order dated 11.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Head Constable Sukhveer, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 11.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
