ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 06.05.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 452, 506, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injuries which were allegedly caused in the incident were simple in nature and the co-accused Sukhwinder Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-23068-2019 on 04.06.2019.

This Court, by the order dated 18.06.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
