ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 128 dated 05.06.2019 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station SirsaSadar, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that 90 grams of heroin was recovered from co-accused Vijay Pal. He also contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, Vijay Pal. He further contends that the recovery of heroin is 90 grams, which is less than the commercial quantity, although it has erroneously been recorded by the trial Court in the order dated 14.06.2019 rejecting his bail that it is a commercial quantity. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 12.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join

the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Ramesh Kumar states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.09.2019 granting ad interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
