Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.347, dated 25.12.2018, registered under Sections 323/324/435/307/34/326 IPC, at Police Station Chandimandir, Tehsil & District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injured was discharged after a period of 12 days. He further submits that the complainant is brother of Assistant Sub Inspector of Police and petitioner has been falsely implicated. He further draws attention of the Court to the fact that as per the FIR, 4 persons were involved, whereas the police after investigation did not find any ground to proceed against two. He further submits that co-accused of the petitioner has already been released on regular bail. He further contends that the investigations are complete and charges have been framed.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the State submits that the petitioner is a main accused and therefore, he should not be released on bail.

On Court question, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, has submitted that there is no other case against the petitioners.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 26.12.2018 and the investigations are already complete. Conclusion of the trial is likely to take long time. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panchkula.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed with the aforesaid direction.
