The assertion of learned counsel for the petitioner that the record is with the BDPO, has been duly admitted in the written statement which states that the record in question was with Panchayat Secretary, Lakhbir Singh, which on registration of the FIR against him, was further handed over to respondent No.4, BDPO, Iqbaljit Singh. In this view of the matter, now at this stage considering the changed circumstances, no such directions can be issued in the matter.
