Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.120 dated 30.05.2019 registered under Sections 354-A, 341, 506 of IPC at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 20.06.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Seema Kumari, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his

the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.06.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main petition seeking anticipatory bail has been allowed, no separate order is required to be passed in the application i.e. CRM-20447-2019 for placing on record the chart (Annexure P/7).
