Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.298 dated 02.06.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 & 307 IPC at Police Station Ambala Cantt.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioners that it is the case of version and cross-version in which both the sides are alleged to have pelted stones/brickbats and glass bottles at each other. However, no injury has been caused to any person from either side. There is no medical record to corroborate any injury having been caused to any person from either side. Otherwise also, no defined weapon was used in the incident. Therefore, the offence under Section 307 IPC is not even attracted in the case.

Learned State counsel being instructed by ASI Jasvinder Singh, Police Station Ambala Cantt., does not dispute the above said facts.

In view of the above the present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
